



Marvellous Me

Our first topic this year is 'Marvellous Me'. This will be a great opportunity to talk about ourselves and get to know each other. We will explore what makes us unique through the story of Elmer. We will then learn to spot visual similarities and differences between us and our friends. We will learn to talk about our immediate families and will spend some time describing special events in our lives. We will be answering the enquiry question - What makes me special?

After half term, we will learn to identify name different feelings and will get to know people in our school who can help us. In addition to this, we will learn about people who help us in our community such as police officers, doctors, lifeguards and fire fighters. We will also investigate the celebrations of Diwali and Christmas and will learn that although people celebrate different things, the way people celebrate is similar. We will be answering the enquiry question - What makes a community?

English

In Phonics, we will begin by exploring Environmental sounds. Environmental sounds are the common noises we hear all around us in our daily lives. Encourage your children to listen and identify sounds when you are at home or out and about. Learning to recognise sounds we hear is an important skill which allows children to understand what's going on in the world around them.

After that, we will be exploring Instrumental sounds. These are the noises creating by musical instruments.

We will also be encouraging the children to learn to mark make with a range of different tools including pencils, crayons, felt tip pens, chalk and paintbrushes. The children will learn to tell an adult about what they have drawn. In addition to this, we will be tracing over different patterns to build up the children's pencil control.

We will of course be listening to lots of different stories and learning to sing lots of different nursery rhymes too!

Maths

We will begin this half term by learning to sort objects in different ways. We will sort objects by size, type and colour. After that, we will be exploring patterns in the world around us. We will look at different patterns and begin to make our own simple repeating patterns. They will have the opportunity to use a wide range of resources in the classroom environment to explore continuing and creating their own patterns in their play.

Following on from this, we will explore time. We will learn to sequence events such as brushing teeth and getting ready for bed. We will use the words first, next and then to order these events.

After that, we will begin to explore number. We will practise counting by saying number names in order and will learn to count objects by touching each one and saying the number names.

Please try to read to your child every day at home. Encourage them to talk about what they have heard and answer simple questions about what is happening.

Listening to stories and developing a love of reading and books at this age will help set them up to become successful readers later on!
