Nut-Free Policy

To help protect all members of our school community, we kindly ask all families to support our nut-free approach.

Please DO NOT send the following into school:

- Peanuts or tree nuts of any kind
- Peanut butter, Nutella, or other nut-based spreads
- Foods containing nuts (e.g. nut bars, nut cakes, nut chocolates)
- Products labelled "*may contain nuts*"

✓ What CAN be sent to school

- Fruit and vegetables
- Cheese, yoghurt, and dairy-based snacks
- Crackers, breadsticks, and plain biscuits (nut-free)
- Meat, fish, or egg-based fillings

***If unsure, please check food labels carefully.*

Why This Matters

Even small traces of nuts can cause:

- Severe allergic reactions
- Breathing difficulties
- Medical emergencies requiring immediate treatment
