COVID-19 Update 4: 20th March 2020 - FINAL

Here is a summary of the key information for you during these unique circumstances. We will continue to keep you updated via the website but will not be running the office and phone lines to full capacity during closure.

- School will be closed to most pupils from 3:15pm Friday 20th March.
- Parents must make every effort to keep their child at home.
- Parents must evidence their key worker status and that of their partner and the shifts they are working to register for childcare unless they are classed as part of the vulnerable group.
- You will be informed if you are eligible to register for childcare provision. If you are, you will need to register at school on Thursday 26th March. Details will follow.
- Homework packs have been sent home with present pupils today.
- Arrangements for collection of homework packs for absent children is available on the school website, please see Update 3 - 20th March 20.
- We will be letting those eligible know about our provision for children in receipt of free school meals. This does not apply to children receiving a meal in KS1 unless registered for free school meals. We have signed up for the voucher scheme and information will be provided to you as soon as we have confirmation of the processes.
- Further homework will be provided on the website if we are still closed in a few weeks time. We will keep you informed.
- Enjoy this time with your children, keep up with their school work and have lots of fun.
- Most importantly keep safe and keep healthy.
