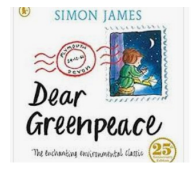

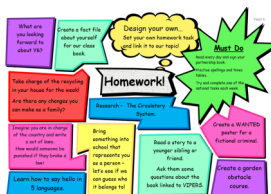


Homework

These tasks will cover a range of skills. Children can choose as many additional tasks as they like to fit in with their busy schedules at home



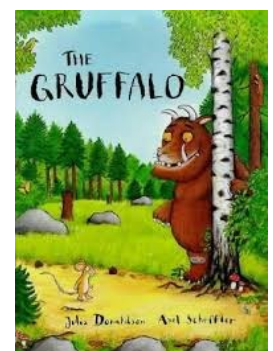
English

Our focus book for our 'Great Outdoors' topic will be The Gruffalo by Julia Donaldson.

We will be writing labels and captions for the characters in the story.

We will be practising our cursive handwriting and keeping all letters sitting on the line.

We will also be using capital letters for names and at the beginning of sentences, as well as finger spaces and full stops.

Maths

Number and Place Value is our focus in Maths.

We will be using number lines, objects and pictures to identify and represent numbers. We will be counting, reading and writing the numbers to 100. We will be saying what is one more or one less than a number up to 100 and we will be able to count forwards and back starting at any number.

We will be starting our fluent in 4 work at the start of most lessons to help support the children to recap on their learning which helps them to remember what they have learnt.

To help at home you could look at number bonds to 10 and see how fast they can remember them. Hit the Button is a great tool for this.
