




TIMES TABLES ROCKSTARS

We had to work out different combinations of input numbers and multiplications that may have taken place. Following that, four new boxes now (with new numbers in) appeared and the large box multiplied by a different number this time. We worked strategically and tried different combinations until we found the solution!



Another challenge that some of us managed to tackle was 'Four Goodness Sake!' We were required to write down the number 4, four times and put operation symbols between them so that we had a calculation.


