Dear Parents and Carers,

Free School Meal Vouchers - are you missing out?

We are writing to all our families again to encourage parents to apply for benefits-related free school meals, and we want to ensure that all of our families who are entitled to these vouchers are receiving them.

Please remember that **benefits-related Free School Meals are available to all eligible children under 16, including children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2** (in addition to receiving Universal Infants Free School Meals).

If you are in receipt of any of the following benefits, you may be eligible:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, but NOT entitled to Working Tax Credit and you have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190, as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs¹
- Support under of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 section 95
- Universal Credit (income thresholds apply)
