The children will explore a range of Victorian artefacts, learn about how life was different in the Victorian era such as homes, food, schools and toys and also learn about Queen Victoria’s life.

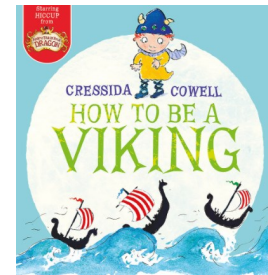

Book recommendation

“How to be a Viking” by Cressida Cowell.



So begins Cressida Cowell’s stories about a little Viking who cannot fit in. Unlike his dad, Stoick the Vast, Hiccup is tiny, thoughtful and polite and scared of almost everything – especially of going to sea for the very first time. But go he must... So who will save the day when everything goes wrong aboard ship and all the big Vikings lose their cool?

Homework

All children will be given homework every Friday. This must be completed by the following Wednesday. Homework given will always be a reconsolidation of learning that has taken place in school.

In addition to this, a homework menu will be provided each half term. These tasks will cover a range of skills. Children can choose as many additional tasks as they like to fit in with their busy schedules at home.

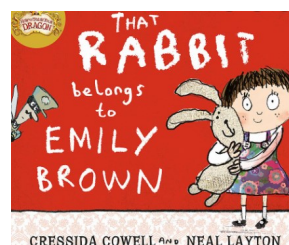


English

This half term, our writing will be based on the learning that will take place about the Victorians. Over the six weeks, we will write a recount, a set of instructions and a setting description.

We will start by recapping simple sentences and then use this to create compound sentences. We will then learn some new writing skills such writing in the present tense, commands, adverbs and commas to list items.

In VIPERS we will be reading the book “That Rabbit Belongs to Emily Brown” by Cressida Cowell.



Maths

Our first will start off by continuing our learning on addition and subtraction using concrete resources, pictorial methods and written methods. We will then move onto to money. The children will learn the different coins and notes, add money together to create the same amounts in different ways and use their knowledge of subtraction to calculate change.

After this, Year 2 will begin their learning of multiplying and dividing by 2, 5 and 10. This will start by recapping counting forwards and backwards in these amounts.

We will also continue with our big push on times-tables, as these form an important basis for many areas of the maths curriculum.

Please encourage your child to access TT Rockstars as often as possible to support them with this essential knowledge.

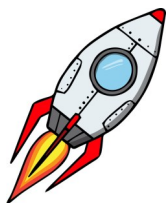
