
Maths



In Maths this half term the children will continue to practise their counting by rote and number recognition daily.

Please practise counting and number recognition skills with your child whenever you can- some examples might be looking at and recognising door numbers or car number plates on the walk to school, counting how many cups or plates are needed at home for a family meal or counting foods as they are prepared for dinner.

There will be a focus to on activities that involve matching numerals to quantity, as well as opportunities for noticing, arranging and talking about simple patterns that the children may see or hear both physical and through sound games and dance where the children will be encouraged to make their own patterns using their body parts or percussion instruments and be prompted to predict what might come next in a pattern sequence.

Each week your child will bring home a 'Reading Record' booklet and a rhyme. It would be fantastic if you are able to read each week's rhyme daily with your child encouraging them to hear and say any rhyming words, as well as listening for initial sounds in words. Please make a brief note in your child's booklet of when they have read -not just our school rhyme but anything else that your child has read with yourself or other family members. Please also use the reading record books to let us know about any activities your child has taken part in and enjoyed so that we can encourage them to share their experiences with the adults and children in class .
