Retell the story of The Great Race to an adult at home. Can you make a simple story map to show what happens in the story?

Look at the different types of transport passing your house. Can you record how many of each vehicle you see?

Fill up a bowl with water (or do this at bath time). Can you find three things that float in the water and three things that sink?

Go on a winter walk, what signs of winter can you see and feel. What clothes did you have to wear to help keep you warm?

Can you complete a weather chart, draw a picture of what the weather is like each day for a week. See if the weather changes or if it stayed the same.
