- Ancient Maya lived in southern Mexico and Central America for over 3000 years.
- They had city-states with their own rulers and surrounded by smaller towns.
- The Maya were advanced, with their own language (Mayan) and a unique way of writing (glyphs).
- They were good at numbers and made their own calendar.
- Farming was crucial; they used 'slash-and-burn' to clear land but had to move after two years.
- The Maya civilization eventually declined due to various reasons like too many people and environmental problems
- The civilisation lasted from 1100BC - 1697AD.
